Hello Judy,

In response to RWQCB comments provided earlier for the Draft Final Feasibility Study Report, Seaplane Lagoon (Site 17) which stated:

Based on the review, Staff cannot accept the Draft Final FS as complete. In the interest of moving the project forward, staff will not object to moving forward to the Record of Decision (ROD), provided the US Navy agrees to re-evaluate the cleanup footprint and cleanup cost using the 200 ppb PCB threshold concentration as a "not to exceed" level prior to the ROD.

The Navy re-evaluated cleanup footprint and the cleanup cost using the criteria you requested.

That information is provided below:

The volume of the proposed footprint if the threshold is a not to exceed value of 200 ppb is 106,000 cubic yards. This would raise the cost of Alternative 5 from \$8,959,000 to \$12,372,466.

Please let me know if you have any further concerns.
