Subj: STATUS OF PROPOSED CLEANUP AT NAVAL AUXILIARY LANDING FIELD,
CROWS LANDING, CALIFORNIA

Dear Mr. Marshall:

As previously discussed with you, the Western Division, Naval Facilities Engineering Command (WESTDIY) has agreed to work jointly with the California Department of Health Services (DHS) on a new technology demonstration project of soil remediation at Naval Auxiliary Landing Field (NALF), Crows Landing, California. The DHS has awarded a demonstration grant to Roy F. Weston, Inc. (WESTON) to demonstrate their Low Temperature Thermal Treatment (LT³) System which remediates petroleum hydrocarbon contaminated soil.

The Navy had negotiated and was close to award of the contract to perform this work. Unfortunately, due to emergent requirements, program funding was reduced for the remainder of fiscal year (FY89). The Navy anticipates that funding will become available at the beginning of FY90 with work to resume in October 1989.

Our revised cleanup schedule follows. We will keep you informed as the situation changes.
