tions. We have been using the money to pay off a city improvement that has created a good business environment and improved the sales-tax base of the community."

Nicholson said the law, as she sees it, simply gives the choice to taxpayers.

"There is nothing in the law that would prevent (voters) from passing a tax for any amenities," she said.

Repealing the levy would require using the city general fund to make the \$226,000 in annual debt payments.

The general fund is currently about \$4 million in the black.

"If we rescind it, I guess we will get by," Weatherford said.

**U.S. Navy Releases Action Memorandum for
Groundwater Response Actions
at NASA Crows Landing Flight Facility**

The Navy has released an Action Memorandum announcing time-critical removal actions to address groundwater contaminated with 1,2-dichloroethane, carbon tetrachloride, and other solvents at the Administration Area Plume at NASA Crows Landing Flight Facility. Response actions are planned near former Underground Storage Tank Site 117 and the Demolished Hangar Area. The Navy invites the public to review and comment on the planned activities described in the Action Memorandum that has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA). The Action Memorandum is available at the Stanislaus County Library, Patterson Branch at 46 North Salado, Patterson, California. The administrative record for these removal actions is available for review through 30 September 2001.
