Hello Jim,

I have attached a map that shows the hydropunch locations and the monitoring well locations that were identified in our transmittal dated 15 November 2001. You requested a map showing hydropunch and well locations in your letter dated 6 December 2001, and the attachment is intended to answer your request.

Also, in your letter dated 6 December 2001, you requested advance notification of drilling activities, and this message is intended to provide that notification.

We understand that you would like to visit the site to observe some of the drilling activities. We appreciate your interest and participation in the fieldwork and we encourage you to visit the site. We would like to request that you coordinate your site visits with the field team so that your visits are scheduled to coincide with the activities of interest. Coordination with Bob Hulet (Project Manager, IT Corporation) at 925 288-2162 or Eddie Ramirez (Project Superintendent, IT Corporation) at 209 837-0416 in advance of your visit will be greatly appreciated.

We have tentatively scheduled hollow-stem auger drilling and well construction activities for 7 January 2002.

We have tentatively scheduled rotasonic drilling activities for the deeper monitoring wells on 28 January 2002. The stratigraphy/lithology will be logged.

Well construction logs will be prepared following the completion of well construction activities, and these logs will be signed by a California RG or PE.

We will update our geological cross sections and hydrogeological model, as appropriate, based upon the information collected during the well construction activities. The new well locations will be added to the basewide map of monitoring wells and to the appropriate maps for IRP Site 17.


We appreciate your concern about the potential impacts to the Administration Area Plume that may be caused by pumping from nearby wells, including the NASA water supply well. You mentioned your concerns in your letter of 6 December 2001. We understand that you have discussed the evaluation of aquifer response to pumping from the NASA water supply well with NASA representatives. We look forward to evaluating NASA's information.

Please let me know if additional information pertaining to well construction activities is required.






PROPOSED MONITORING
