1	1-1	Section 1.0 Paragraph 2 Sentence 1	Change the sentence by adding the italicized words so that it reads: "...was formerly used <i>by the Navy</i> for disposal of..." IRP Site 11 was not used by NASA.	The words "by the Navy" have been added to the text as indicated.
2	2-2	Section 2.1.2 Paragraph 2 Last Sentence	In addition to the uses listed previously in the paragraph, Site 11 was used by the California National Guard for training purposes including a field camp set up at the site.	Comment noted. Although there is documentation of the use of the Facility by the California National Guard for training purposes, there is no additional documentation that indicates that the area of IRP Site 11 within the fence (disposal pits area) was used for training or field camp set up.
3	2-3	Section 2.2 Paragraph 3 Sentence 2	Please check the use of the noun "objectives." It doesn't seem to be appropriately used here.	The sentence has been edited to read "It is therefore the objective of this removal action..."
4	2-3	Section 2.4 Paragraph 2 Sentence 1	The sentence should also add that the land adjacent to Site 11 now belongs to Stanislaus County in addition to be using for agricultural purposes.	The sentence has been edited accordingly.
