1. Reference (a) established a Technical Review Committee (TRC) for the Installation Restoration (IR) program at MCAS El Toro and Tustin. The IR program is the Department of Defense's program to assess and cleanup past disposal sites.

2. One area which has undergone extensive investigation under the IR program is Trichloroethylene (TCE) groundwater contamination. Studies conducted to date have been inconclusive in determining the extent of off-station contamination resulting from MCAS El Toro. The enclosed investigation is designed to confirm and characterize any contamination which may have migrated off of the Air Station.

3. Request all addresses review the enclosure and provide written comments to this command (Code 1JG) by 16 Jan 1990. A TRC meeting will then be held on 23 January 1990 at 1000 in building 65, MCAS El Toro Headquarters. Comments from all members of the TRC will be addressed at this meeting.

4. Community Relations Plans (CRPs) are currently being developed for MCAS El Toro and Tustin. CRPs are designed to better inform the public of our IR program. CRP initiatives and impacts will also be discussed at this TRC meeting.
