1. In response to references (a) and (b), the PRP questions presented by the California Department of Health Services (DHS) for the Lubrication Company of America (LCA) site were reviewed by appropriate organizations at MCAS El Toro and Tustin. As discussed in reference (c), no information could be found with regards to LCA and, consequently, the questions could not be answered.

2. Based on information provided to your command by DHS at the 22 March 1991 PRP meeting, we are aware that records exist which show that MCAS El Toro and Tustin contributed over 11% to the LCA site. Although your command is the lead activity for PRP sites, we request that we be kept closely informed on all developments regarding the LCA site.
