The City of Irvine would appreciate an opportunity to meet with the BRAC Environmental Team (BET) to discuss further research we have conducted in support of our recent request of the Navy to test for the presence of solvents released from the sanitary sewer system at MCAS El Toro.

In discussions with members of the BET, staff and consultants have been asked to address the issue of the consistency of groundwater monitoring data with the recent study on solvent releases prepared by PES Environmental for the City of Irvine. The City has analyzed the available data from the existing groundwater monitoring system and staff would like to present its findings on that issue to the BET.

We would appreciate meeting with you and the participating agencies at your earliest convenience. We would like to request a half hour on the BET agenda to discuss the relationship of the existing groundwater monitoring system and solvent releases from the sanitary sewer system. If time is available at the next meeting on Wednesday, March 29, the City of Irvine would be pleased to make a brief presentation and discuss the issue in detail. The City's consultant Mr. Mike Brown will be contacting you to arrange a meeting.
