

Main Agenda Issues since 30 May 00:

Subcommittee minutes available

Unit A.

*IDP -

The Subcommittee requests that the status of the IDP be permanently added to the RAB Agenda, as long as there is any uncertainty as to its implementation.

Unit B.

* BCP -

A letter submitted by P. Hersh to the DoN regarding LUC's still has had no response. The consensus from other base closures is clear that LUC's should not be left as a post ROD action. The lack of response of the DoN should be reported at the full RAB.

Unit C.

* Drainage Channels, Site 25

Sufficient new evidence has been found to propose that the previous Site 25 NFA decision should be reconsidered by the Agencies:

- 1) radioactivity in the sediments washing off into the Borrego Canyon Wash,
- 2) the admission by the DoN that all of the chlorinated wash solvents were discharged through the storm drains into the drainage channels, and
- 3) the RWQCB presumed in the late 80's that the plume solvents derived from the drainage channels, primarily the Bee Canyon Wash.

What constitutes sufficient evidence to reopen an NFA ROD for the USEPA?

Unit D.

* UST Closure Status -

The Subcommittee requests that Mr. Wm Sedlak report on the UST sites, not just the accounting of numbers of tanks. For example, what was the level of TPH found in which UST sites that exceeded action levels? For which tanks (and what are their volumes) have a request

* Perchlorate -

The Draft Perchlorate Technical Memo was shared with the Subcommittee. Joe Farber is preparing the Subcommittee's questions and comments on this draft report.

Unit F.

* Groundwater Monitoring -

The Subcommittee was not impressed with the Report of the current round of Groundwater Monitoring from November 1998. An ad hoc group (Bell, Bennett, Brown) have agreed to prepare a response for the Agencies, RAB, and DoN.
