

We have completed our review of the Draft Final Sampling and Analysis Plan Amendment dated August 26, 1992, which we received on September 4, 1992. As we indicated verbally, on June 18, 1992 at the Remedial Project Managers (RPM) Meeting, we have no problem with the statistically based sampling approach. We have no significant objections to the amended plan. However, we are concerned that our discussion on anti-strata or non-"blobs" at the June RPM Meeting was not addressed in the amendment. We feel Section 3.1.1 Synopsis of Phase I RI/FS Statistical Sampling Strategy should have discussion for the case/site, for areas which are within the site boundaries, and are not identified as within any individual strata. Are areas which are not included in individual strata (anti-strata), which are inside identified site boundaries will be considered investigated?
