Subject: MCAS El Toro Groundwater Treatment Project

Gentlemen:

A demonstration groundwater treatment project is going to be installed at MCAS El Toro during the next week. Loren Howard of IRWD was previously contacted to coordinate this activity. As part of this project, the reclaim line on base will be used to convey treated groundwater to the one (1) million gallon storage tank near the golf course. This line is currently being used to convey potable water instead of treated wastewater effluent from IRWD.

To accommodate the aforementioned activities, in concurrence with ~~Ensign~~ Mike Rehor of Facilities Management, we are requesting the following adjustments to be coordinated with the base:

1. Lower the high water level in the golf course storage tank 5 to 6 feet by adjusting the altitude valve.
2. Re-install a short spool piece of pipe that was removed from the 10-inch reclaim line on base and which is currently lying on the ground near the potable water line tie-in. This spool piece would be removed after completion of the demo project.

3. Close the valve on the 12-inch or 8-inch line near Building 317 on the south side of the base where IRWD has a 12-inch reclaim line entering the base.
4. Coordinate shutting off potable water supply to the reclaim line that feeds the golf course storage tank with the base contractor to allow making several tap connections into the reclaim line.
