

Dear Mr. Jimenez:

This letter is in response to your solicitation of applicable or relevant and appropriate requirements (ARARs) for Marine Corps Air Station El Toro (MCASET), Operable Unit 1, Regional Ground Water.

Based on our review of the information provided with the ARAR solicitation, it appears that Operable Unit 1 (OU 1) deals only with ground water contamination associated with the MCASET and no specific facilities are identified in OU 1. Therefore, since our ARARs are specific to solid waste disposal sites, OU 1 does not fall within the jurisdiction of the California Integrated Waste Management Board (Board). Consequently, the Board does not have any applicable or relevant and appropriate requirements for the potential remedial actions for OU 1.

Board staff appreciate your consideration in submitting this information for review and look forward to working with you in the future. We understand you will be requesting ARARs in the near future for closure and remediation of disposal sites and for postclosure land uses at the MCASET.
