Rep. Ed Royce, R-Fullerton, said he hopes the bill would encourage the Department of Defense to begin transferring parcels of the base to Orange County — as soon as this year — to help rescue local government from the largest municipal bankruptcy in history.

"This is the best way to make certain that the full 4,700 acres are conveyed to the county and make certain that the taxpayers are the beneficiaries of that conveyance and the property isn't given away," Royce said Wednesday.

While Royce sees the Marine base as an asset to be seized for local government, Pentagon officials have blanched at the proposal to circumvent a process laid out in detailed policies and base-closure laws.

Royce's legislation would require the Department of Defense to transfer the land to the county no later than when the base closes by the end of the century.

But officials in south-county cities echoed the comments of Lake Forest Mayor Richard Dixon, who said the county's bankruptcy crisis is a reason not to transfer the base.

"To be turning things over to the current cadre of Board of Supervisors based on their track record doesn't make sense," Dixon said.

Voters have authorized a commercial airport for the base land.

**N**EW YORK—Just hours after a massive car bomb ripped apart a federal office building in Oklahoma City on Wednesday, witnesses at the domestic terrorism trial of Sheik Omar Abdel Rahman—over the objection of defense attorneys—described the horror of the 1993 bombing of New York's World Trade Center.
