Dear Ms. Rudolph

I have been asked to represent the OU-2 Subcommittee and present the comments to the subject documents. The subcommittee met on May 19, 1995 to discuss the documents with the following subcommittee members in attendance: Maria Shayegan, John Westermeier, and myself. I was to compile the written comments and present them at tonight's RAB meeting. Since no other written comments were faxed to me the following comments are my own but from our conversations I believe them to be representative of the subcommittee's position. Jerard B. Werner was unable to participate in our meeting and presented a separate letter of comments to Joseph Joyce. A copy of his comments are attached (see next AR file listing)

The Work Plan and Field Sampling Plan document preparation was well done. The objective of the work to be done was well stated. The objective is to collect sufficient information to support decision making required to determine risks associated with sites and the appropriate response action. The decisions for selecting appropriate response actions include: early action, long term action and no further response action planned (NFRAP).

The work plan rationale described is well thought out, reasonable and appears to account for all reasonable possibilities. The RI/FS tasks are described in detail and appear to be a reasonable approach to meeting the objective. The schedule seems reasonable with a start date in July, 1995 and final reports completed by January, 1997 for OU-2 and June, 1997 for OU-3

The organization of the report is good, especially the appendices for the work plan and attachments for the sampling plan. Each appendix/attachment has a self contained description of the plans complete with background information with each site.
