
Dear Joseph:

Reference is made to the Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS) El Toro, Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) meeting of July 27, 1995. In response to a call for the upcoming RAB meetings issues, I requested an investigation of the potential mobilization of debris and leaching of contaminants by Borrego Creek at the Magazine Road landfill.

Because of recent development-related upstream modifications to Borrego Creek, the potential for deviations to the existing alignment of the earthen wash has increased. In the event the wash migrates into the landfill, the already abutting wash will further scour the landfill and displace debris and contaminants now contained within the MCAS.

Please have RAB staff research the issue and furnish a listing of the completed studies and reports which discuss the landfill. Upon completion, the listing should be given to the RAB Board to determine further investigation requirements.
