Dear Ms. Hornecker:

This is in response to the workplan dated December 4, 1996, regarding rehabilitation and development of the air sparging well located at underground tank site 398. You are proposing to add approximately one gallon of hydroxyacetic acid (glycolic acid) to the air sparge well to dissolve carbonate deposits, to disinfect the well and to inhibit further deposition of minerals.

Based on the information provided in the work plan, the rehabilitation procedure will not adversely impact water quality. Therefore, we have no objection to the proposed rehabilitation and development project.
