CLOSURE NOTIFICATION: MARINE CORPS AIR STATION EL TORO, EL TORO,
CALIFORNIA (EPA ID NO. CA6170023208)

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (Department) has received your letter dated October 31, 1994 regarding the closure of the Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS) El Toro facility. On August 18, 1993, the Department issued a Hazardous Waste Facility Permit to MCAS El Toro for storing hazardous waste. The permit authorizes MCAS El Toro to store a maximum of 370 55-gallon drums of waste in Building 673-T3. Your letter indicated that MCAS El Toro ceased storage of hazardous waste in Building 673-T3 on August 18, 1994, this is the date when MCAS El Toro received the final volume of hazardous wastes.

Pursuant to the California Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 22, Division 4.5, Section 66264.113, MCAS El Toro shall begin and complete closure of Building 673-T3, respectively 90 and 180 days from August 18, 1994 when the final volume of hazardous wastes was received. The Department may consider extension of these due dates if MCAS El Toro submits a timely request in accordance with 22 CCR 66264.113(c) and 66270.42. MCAS El Toro shall close Building 673-T3 as specified in the approved closure plan included in the Part B Permit Application dated June 29, 1992.
