SUBJECT: DELIVERY OF THE DRAFT WORK PLAN, SOIL VAPOR EXTRACTION PILOT TEST, INSTALLATION RESTORATION PROGRAM SITE 16, FORMER MARINE CORPS AIR STATION (MCAS) EL TORO, CALIFORNIA

Submitted for your review is the Draft Work Plan for the implementation of a soil vapor extraction (SVE) pilot test for IRP Site 16 at Former MCAS El Toro, California. The Final Site Assessment Report recommended a pilot test for SVE be conducted at the site to evaluate the effectiveness of the technology in removing total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH) in the soil to reduce the potential for TPH to impact groundwater. The Draft Work Plan includes a Sampling and Analysis Plan that presents the approach for operating the SVE system and methods for sampling to be conducted as part of the pilot test. The SVE system has been designed to also address residual volatile organic compounds (VOCs) detected in the soil.
