Subj: Suspected UST Site 49
Former Marine Corps Air Station, El Toro

Prior to the BRAC Cleanup Team meeting of 28 May 2003, the possibility of an underground storage tank site at Building 49 at the former Marine Corps Air Station, El Toro was discussed. We received part of the State of California's GeoTracker list on 28 May 2003, and the GeoTracker list identifies Case Number 083002943T for a tank site at Building 49.

We reviewed historical records and drawings, and we compiled the attached Information Package for Suspected Underground Storage Tank (UST) Site 49. We do not believe that an underground storage tank was constructed at Building 49 based upon the review of the historical documentation. The records show that Building 49, a former hangar, was heated by several space heaters. It is possible that an underground tank at one of the nearby buildings was inadvertently identified on the GeoTracker list as a tank at Building 49.

We recommend that no further actions are required for the suspected tank site at Building 49. If we do not receive comments from your office within sixty (60) days of receipt of this transmittal, then we will assume that you concur with our evaluation.
