Purpose of the Meeting
The South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) has scheduled a public workshop to solicit comments and suggestions from the public on **Proposed Amendments to the Rule 2202 Employee Commute Reduction Program (ECRP) Guidelines.**

The proposed amendments will be considered by the SCAQMD Governing Board at a public hearing scheduled for May 1, 2015. This public workshop will allow for comments and discussion of the proposed guidelines amendments with all public members including potentially impacted stakeholders and other interested parties.

Summary of Proposed Guideline Amendments
The guideline applies to employers subject to Rule 2202 who choose to implement an Employee Commute Reduction Program (ECRP). Employers implementing an ECRP are required to submit an annual plan to comply with the rule. The proposed amendments are intended to streamline the submittal of ECRPs and incentivize average vehicle ridership (AVR) improvements through the reduction of filing fees and administrative plan filings.

The proposed guideline amendments include:
- Allow High AVR and AVR Improvement for qualifying employers to submit streamlined annual plans at a discounted fee to incentivize program improvements
- If applicable, employers with 4 or more fleet vehicles will no longer be required to submit an Employer Clean Fleet Purchase/Lease Program due to advances in vehicle emission standards that address the typical vehicle that is acquired for use in fleets
- If applicable, employers with on-site diesel equipment will not be required to submit a Mobile Source Diesel PM/NOx Emission Minimization Program due to CARB's in-use off-road diesel vehicle regulation
- Other administrative amendments to the guideline
