Gentlemen:

We have received your Tentative Site Cleanup Order (File No. 2169.6032) for Ex-Hunters Point Naval Shipyard, San Francisco, California. As we indicated during our meeting with Mr. William Hurly of your staff on June 18, 1987, the Navy is currently assessing the technical and legal aspects of the tentative order, its proper addressee, and its effect on the ongoing hazardous waste Remedial Investigations and Feasibility Studies (RI/FS) at the Hunters Point facility. Because of the complexity of the RI/FS under the Installation Restoration Program, we request an extension of the due date for our comments on the tentative order to July 15, 1987 in order to properly review the document and to ensure that our RI/FS program meets Environmental Protection Agency, Department of Health Services, and Regional Water Quality Control Board requirements under the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1986.

We appreciate your support in this endeavor and look forward to a close working relationship as we press forward with the Installation Restoration Program at Hunters Point.
