Thank you for your letter of 2 November 1987, describing the CERCLA requirements and EPA guidelines, rules, and regulations applicable to the conduct of removal actions and remedial actions at the Naval Station Treasure Island, Hunter's Point Annex. As you are aware we have already submitted the Draft Scoping Document for the Remedial Investigations/Feasibility Studies for Hunters Point to both your office and interested State agencies for review. Section 1.2 of the Scoping Document describes the coordination that will be undertaken between the Navy, EPA and State agencies. In addition, since we last met we are reassessing whether removal actions may be appropriate for the Pickling Plate Yard, the Battery and Electroplating Shop, and the Tank Farm. We will involve EPA and the interested State agencies in any such planning.

We appreciate your interest in this project and look forward to working with you.
