This letter is to follow up on the report titled, "Verification of Hazardous Waste Contamination at Specified Sites, Hunters Point Naval Shipyard, San Francisco, California, October 30, 1987" prepared by our consultant, EMCOW Associates. This report was given to your staff and members of the Regional Water Quality Control Board during a meeting held in your office on November 3, 1987 to discuss the remedial investigation at Hunters Point.

The report mentioned above summarizes the field and analytical data at specific locations outside current remedial investigation sites where alleged illegal disposal activities were conducted by Triple A Machine Shop. We are analyzing these and other data to determine whether these sites warrant additional study and/or inclusion into the remedial investigation.
