Dear Mr. Clifford:

In accordance with Section 120(d) of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act as amended by the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1986, a Hazard Ranking System (HRS) package and the Initial Assessment Study report for Naval Station, Treasure Island, Hunters Point Annex (HPA) (enclosures (1) and (2)) are submitted. The HRS package ranks the entire area of HPA and includes a narrative description of the HPA site, Potential Hazardous Waste Site Preliminary Assessment worksheets, HRS worksheets, HRS documentation record, and a bibliography that supports the HRS package. Copies of the references in the bibliography are available upon request.

As discussed in our letter of January 29, 1988 to Mr. Nick Morgan of your Agency, we have done extensive research into the water source (spring) for the Mountain Spring Water Company as it relates to groundwater uses at HPA. The groundwater exposure route HRS score was developed using the fact that the source for the Mountain Spring Water Company, which is located within one mile of the site, is not considered a groundwater well. It is currently defined as a surface water source based on information obtained during a site visit by our consultants, Harding Lawson Associates, with representatives of the Mountain Spring Water Company. The spring is topographically and hydraulically "upstream" from the HPA site. In addition, it was determined that the source of the Mountain Spring Water Company is not associated with the aquifer of concern at HPA.
