Subject: Solid Waste Assessment Test (SWAT) Proposal - Hunters
Point Annex

Dear Lieutenant Commander Michlin:

Regional Board staff have reviewed the portions of the December 5, 1988 Group 1 Sampling Plan which relate to the SWAT Proposal request of April 6, 1988 (i.e. Industrial Landfill, Bay Fill Area and Burning Disposal Sites). Staff have determined that the Navy's response to the SWAT proposal request is incomplete. The Regional Board's letter of April 6, 1988 specified that a SWAT be performed for four sites at Hunters Point Annex; the three sites mentioned above and Triple A Machine Shop site PA-12. Based on the February 9, 1989 letter from Naval Facilities Engineering Command, it is Regional Board staff's understanding that a workplan proposal for site PA-12 will be pending the results of the Preliminary Assessment/Site Inspection of the site, which will determine whether conditions at PA-12 warrant incorporation into the Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS) for Hunters Point Annex. Please note that a SWAT is required for PA-12 regardless of whether the site is included in the RI/FS or not. The SWAT Proposal for this site will be reviewed by Regional Board staff upon receipt.

Regional Board staff have determined that the workplan proposals for the Industrial Landfill, Bay Fill Area and Burning Disposal sites are consistent with the State Water Resource Control Board's SWAT Guidance Document. However, the SWAT Proposal for Hunters Point Annex will be considered incomplete until a satisfactory workplan is submitted for the PA-12 site.
