EPA's comments on the **Draft Work Plan for Sampling and Analysis of Untreated and Treated Sandblasting Grit at NSTI, Hunters Point Annex** are as follows.

1. **Pages 8-9, § 2.5, Sample Analysis.** As I discussed with Jeff Heath by phone, you need to add a priority pollutant analysis to determine whether any organic substances are present.

2. **Page 12, §3.1.2.5.** What will be the basis for determining whether three, four, or five samples are taken within a given grid?

3. **Page 20, §5.5.** What is the rationale for leaving the disposable materials at the site until the field demonstration phase, rather than disposing of them immediately or placing them in the storage area for IR field work wastes? Are these to be tested to determine whether they are "hazardous waste"?
