Dear Ms. Lew:

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the above-referenced draft environmental sampling and analysis plan.

Under the McAtteer-Petris Act, the Commission has bay jurisdiction up to the line of highest tidal action and shoreline band jurisdiction in the area 100 feet inland from the line of highest tidal action. A federal agency must submit a consistency determination for activity within the Commission's jurisdiction and for activity that will directly affect the coastal zone. It appears that all or part of your project site is within the Commission's jurisdiction. However, no consistency determination will be required given that the testing and monitoring involve a small amount of soil removal which will likely have a de minimus effect on the coastal zone. Please note that a consistency determination will be required if remedial work or more extensive monitoring and testing are proposed.
