Final Record of Decision for Parcel D-2



September 2010

The Department of the Navy announces that the Final Record of Decision for No Further Action at Parcel D-2 has been signed by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, California Department of Toxic Substances Control, and the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board.

The Navy has concluded no further action under Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) is necessary to ensure protection of human health or the environment at Parcel D-2. Current conditions at the site do not pose an unacceptable risk to human health or the environment for current or future uses of Parcel D-2.
