Dear Ms. Blank, Ms. Arthur, and Ms. Smith:

Under the provisions of Sections 9.3 and 12.3 of the Federal Facility Agreement, the Navy hereby seeks to engage in informal dispute resolution among the Remedial Project Managers concerning the denial of the Navy's 21 January 1992 request for extension.

We propose that the Remedial Project Managers meet at WESTDIV on Thursday, 6 February 1992 at 9:30 a.m., or at the earliest mutually acceptable opportunity, for the purpose of conducting informal dispute resolution. In the event we cannot meet and resolve this matter before the close of business Friday, 7 February 1992, please consider this our formal invocation of dispute resolution. For purposes of the information required pursuant to Section 12.2 of the Federal Facility Agreement, we attach as enclosure (1) and incorporate by reference our letter of 21 January 1992, which sets out the particulars forming the basis for our request for extension.
