Subject: Draft Final Parcel D Site Inspection Report

Dear Mr. Radzevich:

Pursuant to the Federal Facility Agreement (FFA) for the Hunters Point Annex, draft final primary documents become final documents if no disputes are raised within 30 days of the submittal of the draft final document to the agencies. While the Site Inspection (SI) reports themselves are secondary documents, the Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS) workplans are generally identified as primary documents. In the case of Parcel D, the RI Workplan for Preliminary Assessment sites is incorporated in the SI Report.

As per the Navy's cover letter to the Draft Final Parcel D Site Inspection Report and a confirmation phone call with yourself, the Navy has extended, for this report, the 30 day review period to 45 days, requesting agency reviews by July 15, 1994. This letter is to confirm that U.S. EPA will be submitting its review of the Draft Final Parcel D SI Report by the July 15, 1994 deadline identified by the Navy in its letter of May 27, 1994.
