PARCEL B INFORMAL DISPUTE; HUNTERS POINT NAVAL SHIPYARD

Dear Mr. McClelland:

Pursuant to the conversation of July 9, 1999, between Mr. Chien Kao of DTSC and Mr. Hank Gee of EFA West, DTSC and the Navy have agreed to extend the informal dispute period for the Parcel B Remedial Design until July 30, 1999. This extension is intended to allow project managers for DTSC and the Navy to resolve the final wording needed for the Appendix to the Remedial Design Documents as well as to address the concerns expressed by EPA regarding the Land Use Control Implementation Plan being proposed by the Navy. EPA has previously requested an extension to July 28, 1999, to resolve those issues.

We have discussed our decision to join you in extending the informal dispute period with Region IX of the US environmental Protection Agency. They have concurred with this approach.
