Subj: PRE-DRAFT REMOVAL SITE EVALUATION REPORT FOR SITE 6A NAVAL  
STATION, LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA

1. The following comments are provided from review of subject document:

- a. Page 2, section 2, fourth paragraph of 2.1; Please correct the spelling of "Rollefson" at end of paragraph, and in section 10, page 10-2.
- b. Page 2, section 2, fifth and sixth paragraph of 2.1; The Seabee building is not 409, it is 95. (The Seabee Unit number is 409). The building in the scrapyard that you list as 95 is actually building 598. These are also incorrect on almost all of the figures provided in this report. Please check all figures that show an overall layout of site 6A.
- c. Figure 2-2; This drawing is not correct for site 4. Site 4 is the full width of the mole.
- d. Page 2-5 of section 2, 1st and 2nd paragraph; Same as item b above. Also shown incorrectly on drawing prior to page 2-5.
- e. Page 2-5 of section 2, 2nd paragraph; The above ground water tank you describe is owned by the Long Beach Naval Shipyard, not the Coast Guard.
- f. Page 5-9 of section 5, 1st paragraph of section 5.3.2; The last sentence in this paragraph is a reference. I think the date should be 1987, not 1897? In addition, the reference for Gilbert on page 10-1 says 1989. Are these the same references?
- g. Figures 6-2 through 6-15; These drawings all have shaded areas depicting where various contaminants are located. The legend for all drawings say shaded areas are "AREA OF PCB'S ABOVE PRG'S ..." I think this is a misprint on all drawings except for those depicting PCB's.
- h. Page 7-14 of section 7, 1st and 2nd paragraphs of section 7.2.3.1; These two paragraphs repeat a lot

of the same information. Delete 2nd paragraph?

- i. Page 7-17 of section 7, last paragraph of section 7.2.3.4; Please change "Long Beach Naval Station" to "Naval Station Long Beach" in the second sentence.
- j. Comment/question- I don't see anything written in this document that states who will be labeling drums, doing manifests, disposing of wastes, etc.. Will that be addressed in a separate document? Has a decision been made to have Clean II do this on site 6 and other sites in RI/FS?
