MEETING BEGAN AT 7 PM - Anna Ulaszewski, Navy Co-Chair presiding.

**Administrative Issues**

The RAB meeting minutes of 19 March 1996 were approved with the following corrections:  
Don May wanted the record to reflect that he did not agree with the statistics performed in support of the Draft Remedial Investigation Report for IR Site 7 and that the data presented in Tech Memo 6 was different than the draft RI data.

Alan Lee reviewed the 1 April 1996 News article from the Daily Breeze regarding the Long Beach Harbor.

The RAB discussed correspondence from RAB Member Don May regarding: (a) his request for copies of the entire IR Site 7 RI (Volumes 1-7); and, (b) his request for a 90-day extension to review the documents. The Navy provided copies of Volumes 1-7 to Don May on 2 April 1996. RAB member Dr. Robert Kanter commented that a 90-day extension would significantly impact the schedule for Reuse activities, and that he could not support such an extension. Don May explained that he had several questions regarding lab certification, and data validation performed as part of this RI effort. The Navy agreed to conduct an additional Technical Workshop on Site 7 to attempt to clarify information. Don May agreed to withdraw his request for a 90-day extension to review the document pending the results of the workshop. Don May, David Sundstrom, Karl Tiedemann and Richard Landgraff all submitted written comments on the Site 7 RI seeking clarification of specific information presented in the report. The Technical Workshop was scheduled for 7 May 1996, from 6-9 p.m. at the Long Beach Naval Shipyard, Building 5.

### **Port of Long Beach Presentation - Reuse Activities**

Dr. Robert Kanter, Assistant Director of Planning for the POLB, presented the status of POLB-related Reuse activities. Dr. Kanter explained the dredging project proposed for the Harbor, and the lease of a portion of the Mole from POLB to BOEING for their SeaLaunch Project. Dr. Kanter explained the details of each project, the various environmental elements of each project, and the special studies being conducted by the POLB to support these future Reuse activities.

### **Receive Comments on the Draft Remedial Investigation report for IRP Site 7 (The Harbor)**

Written comments were collected from Richard Landgraff, Don May, David Sundstrom and Karl Tiedemann. Jennifer Rich, DTSC Community Participation Specialist, facilitated the effort. Joan Greenwood asked questions regarding the holding time for the samples collected, QA/QC protocol, lab certification and surrogate samples. Mike Radecki, Lead RPM at SWDIV, responded to the oral questions asked by the RAB. Written responses will be provided at the Technical Workshop scheduled for 7 May 1996 (discussed further above).

### **Election of 1996 Community Co-Chair/Revision to the Rules of Operation**

The RAB membership elected to have Donna DiRocco serve as Community Co-Chair for another year. The Rules of Operation will be revised for the new 1996-1997 RAB year.

### **Open Meeting to RAB Members and Members of the Audience**

The RAB would like to review the agency comments on the draft RI for IR Site 7.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:10 P.M.
