MEETING BEGAN AT 7 PM - Richard Landgraff, Community Co-Chair, presiding as Chair.

The Chair welcomed the RAB members, and members of the audience. The Chair further stated that, "It is DoD policy that all RAB meetings are open to the public. Attendance is not limited to RAB members only. These RAB meetings are intended to give the community an opportunity to provide input into the environmental restoration process." In addition, the Chair reminded the RAB members and members of the audience to pick up the handouts at the front table, especially a copy of the executed Rules of Operation.

The RAB members and audience were reminded to please sign in (PRINT LEGIBLY) - *"The sign-in sheet is the official record of attendance for each RAB meeting. It is the responsibility of each and every RAB member to sign into the official record. If you do not sign in, you did not attend the meeting"*.

The Chair reminded the RAB members that the meeting was being tape recorded. No objections were voiced from the floor.

Administrative Issues

The Chair asked for comments on the 20 May 1997 meeting minutes. The minutes were approved with no corrections.

Status of RAB Membership

The Chair, Richard Landgraff, presented the following status to the RAB members:

As directed by the RAB members, Donna DiRocco and I met to discuss the status of the membership of the RAB. Subsequently, a meeting was held which included the Navy and DTSC's Public Participation Specialist to review the outcome of the effort of Donna and I. The final recommendation was to go out and solicit 10 new members. We have here tonight, extra copies of the new membership applications, see Kathy. The deadline for the application submittal is 18 August 1997 and the membership selection committee, made up of myself, Donna and Roberta Johnson, the Navy and DTSC's Public Participation Specialist, Jennifer Rich, will meet on 19 August to review the applications. Hopefully, we will have 10 new members to welcome at the 16 September 1997 RAB meeting.

[NOTE: Subsequent to the 15 July 1997 RAB meeting, it became necessary to extend the application deadline time 30 days. The membership selection committee then met on 29 September 1997 to review the thirteen (13) applications which were submitted. Of the 13, eight (8) were selected to be new RAB members. These members were then notified by telephone and will be introduced at the 18 November 1997 RAB meeting.]

Update - Status of IR Site 7 (the Harbor)

The Contract Task Order Leader for Site 7, Omar Kadaster, and SWDIV RPM Mike Radecki, will lead a discussion on the recent activities which have taken place in an attempt to finalize the remedial investigation report.

Mike Radecki stated that it has been about 14 months since the Draft Remedial Investigation report was issued for review and comments. During the past 14 months, the Navy has worked diligently with the agencies to resolve issues raised by the agencies and the RAB. There were some very strong opinions about the document's completeness, the validity of the data and whether we did what we actually said we were going to do. A new Draft-Final document is currently out for review and I think you will find that in cooperation with the agencies, we have produced a document that has addressed the concerns of both the agencies and the RAB. The conclusions have not changed significantly. What has changed is the manner in which they were presented, and the future steps to be taken. With that, Mike Radecki introduced Omar Kadaster, to present a summary of the issues raised, and the resolution of these issues.

Omar Kadaster, an overview of the issues of concern, the work that was done to resolve the issues, and the resolution to these issues. The following list is the summary of issues of concern by the agencies and the RAB:

- Quality and usability of the analytical data;
- Usability of Reference Station Grouping 40010;
- Sediment Evaluation Zones (SEZs);

- Analysis of data by a method other than SEZs;
- Lack of a reference pier made it difficult to reliably interpret beneath-pier benthic community data, thereby adversely affecting the conclusions; and
- The No Further Action conclusion of the Draft Remedial Investigation Report was a concern to the Agencies/Trustees and the RAB.

Update - The Radiological Survey and Workplan (G-RAM Survey)

Bob O'Brien and Richard Wolf of Digital Systems Research (DSR) presented the details of the workplan for the radiological decommissioning of the Long Beach Naval Complex. This effort is not part of the overall 'BRAC' closure process, but is required by NAVSEA upon the decommissioning of a shipyard.
