1. Enclosure (1) identifies Naval Air Station, North Island as a PRP with respect to the generation, treatment, or transport of hazardous wastes associated with the Lubrication Company of America (LCA) site in Canyon Country, California. A copy was faxed to your office on 26 February 1991.

2. LCA operated this facility during the approximate time frame of 1960 - 1976. Reference (a) defines the efforts an installation must perform when notified as a PRP. We request your assistance in addressing the PRP questions presented by the California Department of Health Services (DHS).

3. The original deadline of 15 March 1991 set by DHS has been extended to 22 March 1991 per reference (b); also discussed was the tentative scheduling of a technical meeting on 22 March 1991. This command will be attending as representative for the Navy. So that the State's new deadline can be met, please furnish to this command by 19 March 1991 a copy of your responses to DHS questions. Include as part of your answers whether or not recycled oil was ever purchased from LCA by Naval Air Station, North Island. Your local Public Works Center and Defense Reutilization and Marketing Office may be sources for additional information.
