ACTION REQ'D. BY	ITEM
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A meeting was held on 7 July 1993 at 1300 hours to discuss the public meeting for Naval Complex (NC) Long Beach planned for 14 July 1993. These meeting minutes provide a summary of the topics discussed.

Copies of the Revised Draft Community Relations Plan (CRP) were distributed to the Navy and Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) participants at the beginning of the meeting. The document incorporates comments received from DTSC at the 8 June 1993 meeting (see PN-0249/250-33). The schedule for finalizing the document was discussed and it was decided that comments would be submitted to the Jacobs Team on 13 July. The Final CRP would then be due 2 weeks later on 27 July.

Anna Ulaszewski confirmed that the public notice had been submitted to the newspapers and should have run on 7 July. She will forward copies of the notices from the papers to the Jacobs Team for inclusion in the Administrative Record.

The slides and handouts for the public meeting were reviewed and revisions to be made were noted. Duane Rollefson will get the sound system and screen, and the Jacobs Team will bring the slide projector. We will meet a 5:00 pm on 14 July in the Officer's Club to set up and provide time for Captain Janov to familiarize himself with the presentation. For the purposes of ordering refreshments and preparing handouts, LCDR Snyder said to expect no more than 50 people.

There was some discussion as to what community relations activities may be required for interim actions that are planned for Site 6A and Site 11. C. Best said that she will clarify whether there is a requirement for a public comment period. If there is time, a public notice or a fact sheet could be issued. The interim actions will be mentioned briefly during the public meeting.

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The meeting concluded at 1430 hours.
