## **FINAL PRELIMINARY ASSESSMENT REPORT FOR 25 AREAS OF CONCERN AT LONG BEACH NAVAL SHIPYARD, LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA**

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has completed its review of the *Final Preliminary Assessment Report (Final PA) for 25 Group B Areas of Concern (AOC) at Long Beach Naval Shipyard, Long Beach, California*, dated June 1998. The *Final PA* report was prepared by CDM Federal Programs Corporation in San Diego.

The 182 AOCs were called "Group B AOCs", of which 25 were evaluated under an expedited PA. The *Final PA* report recommended the following:


- A Thirteen of the 25 AOCs evaluated are recommended for no further action in the *Final PA* report.
- B. Sites for further action include: 1) two of the three drain line systems (Sanitary Sewer System and Storm Water System Drain Lines), 2) three drydocks (Drydocks 1, 2, and 3 Water tunnels), 3) one hazardous waste facility (Building 98), 4) two historical sites (Building 162A and Gun Mount Storage, and Repair Yard), 5) one Public Works yard (Building 5); and 6) three Underground Storage Tank (UST 5, 6, and 15) sites which will be evaluated under the basewide UST Program.

DTSC is satisfied with the response to comments submitted by the Navy for the *Final PA* report and has no additional comments on the document. As a result, the Department hereby concurs with this *Final PA* report.
