This memo incorporates Marsha Mingay's and my comments on the draft final Community Relations Plan (CRP) for the Long Beach Naval Complex (LBNC), dated August 1998. Once these comments are incorporated, we will consider the document approved. Our comments are as follows:

Signature Page

Please include a signature line for the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) Public Participation Specialist (PPS).

Page 1-2

Sixth bullet item - Please change "21068" to "21000 et seq.". I apologize for giving you the wrong section in my first set of comments.

Page 2-2

Paragraph 2, Line 2 - Please delete "and" and insert "which" in its place.

Page 2-5 and 2-6, 2.3.2 "Removal Action Process"

Bullet Item 1 - Please change the first sentence to read, "Emergency removal actions are those actions requiring cleanup activities to begin onsite within hours of the lead agency's determination that a removal action is appropriate."

Bullet Item 2 - Please change the first sentence to read, "Time critical removal actions are those actions requiring cleanup activities to begin onsite within six months of the lead agency's determination that a removal action is appropriate."

Bullet Item 3 - Please change the first sentence to read, "Non-time critical removal actions are those actions not requiring cleanup activities to begin onsite within six months after the lead agency's determination that a removal action is appropriate." Under "AM", please delete the second sentence. It would be more appropriate under the bullet item "Time Critical Removal Actions". Please change the third sentence to read, "The draft AM is normally announced with the EE/CA in a public notice."

Page 2-9, Table 2-1

Under the heading "Community Relations Activity" please include "Direct Mailing" and "Posting Notices". For the "CERCLA Steps" associated with each of these activities please place an "X" under "PP". This will address the state requirements for public participation (California Health and Safety Code, Section 25356.1).

Please delete the "a" reference placed after "RA". It is confusing.

"Community Interviews" and its reference ("b") is also confusing. Community interviews during the remedial action process would be conducted prior to the Remedial Investigation (RI) phase and if necessary, prior to the Remedial Design (RD) phase. Please make the appropriate changes.

Page 2-11, Table 2-2

Please delete the two columns under "Emergency^a Removal Action" and insert a new column titled, "On-Site Activity Lasts Less than 30 Days". Place an "X" for the following activities "Administrative Record", "Involve Restoration Advisory Board" and "Contact State & Local Officials".

Please delete reference "d".

Please include a footnote at the bottom of the table explaining that if a removal action is conducted and it's equivalent to the state's Remedial Action Plan (RAP), it must meet the requirements of the California Health and Safety Code, Section 25356.1. Those additional public participation activities would include direct mailings, posting notices and conducting a public meeting.

Page 2-13, Figure 2-1

This figure is too complicated and confusing. Please remove the figure from the CRP and replace with a figure that will be easier for the public to understand (see Attachment 1 for example).

Page 4-3, 4.1.3 "Community Services"

It would be helpful to explain what geographical population the "West End Community Association" and the "East Village Community Association" serve and the services they provide.


