Dear Mr. Dunaway:

The Department of Toxic Substances Control has reviewed the above-referenced document and has the following comments for your consideration:

1. The proposed soil and groundwater samples should include all constituents detected in the past (VOCs, SVOCs, TPH, Metals, and PCBs) to better define the extent of the entire contamination and in order to determine the best remedial alternative for the area.
2. Page 23, the proposed wells should be initially sampled quarterly analyzing for all detected constituents (VOCs, SVOCs, TPH, Metals, and PCBs). Depending on the results, the frequency and list can be adjusted accordingly after discussions with the regulatory agencies.
