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SUBJECT: **Review of the Draft Work Plan Remedial Investigation at UXO-3 Dredge Pond 3E, Northern Marine Corps Firing Range Mare Island Shipyard, California July 2012**

As request by the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC), Environmental Management Branch (EMB), of the California Department of Public Health (CDPH)) reviewed documents associated with radiological contamination within the "Draft Work Plan, Remedial Investigation at UXO-3 Dredge Pond 3E and Northern Marine Corps Firing Range Former Mare Island Shipyard, California July 20, 2012. The Department of Navy (DON) is not seeking radiological unrestricted release recommendation (RURR) for "Dredge Pond 3E" and "Northern Marine Corps Firing Range". These two areas may be subject to a radiological license or license exemption from the CDPH-Radiological Health Branch (RHB) if radiological sources or contamination is found. If DON changes the status of the two areas during the radiological investigation and seeks a (RURR) then the areas will need to be completely characterized and remediated before EMB can process a (RURR).
