Authorities seek car, cash in Fairfield drug case

FAIRFIELD — The 2004 Acura and \$15,296 in cash seized from an Alameda County man should be forfeited, asserts a civil asset case filed after Fairfield police arresting the man on suspicion of marijuana cultivation, possessing the drug for sale and theft of utility services.

A March 4, 2016, case management conference is set in the Solano County Superior Court filing about assets of Daxian Chen, 25, arrested New Year's Day at a Niagara Way residence in Fairfield.

Chen is scheduled to be sentenced Sept. 24 in the

separate criminal case.

According to a document filed for the civil asset case, detectives were monitoring the activities of Chen, who had been seen at the Niagara Way location several times in the weeks before Jan. 1.

He tried to prevent law enforcement from entering the home Jan. 1 by slamming a side garage door, according to the filing.

Pacific Gas & Electric Company responded to shut off electricity and discovered an illegal bypass that resulted in the theft of thousands of dollars of electrical power, the filing adds.


