Dear Ms. Squires:

Thank you for meeting with me via conference call on April 17, 2001 to discuss Navy environmental restoration activities at former Naval Air Station Moffett Field (now part of NASA Ames Research Center, called Moffett Federal Airfield [MFA]). This letter provides follow-up documentation to our conference call.

Based on our discussion on April 17, it is our understanding that the Santa Clara Valley Water District (SCVWD) is the owner of a saltwater pond, known as "Pond A4", which is adjacent to Moffett Channel and downstream of the Northern Channel. You indicated that SCVWD does not currently have chemical data for Pond A4 or Moffett Channel and expressed interest in being kept abreast of environmental activities at the Northern Channel and Moffett Channel. We would like to set up another conference call to discuss SCVWD involvement in MFA activities and would appreciate if SCVWD could provide a list of questions or items of specific interest for the discussion. Per your request, the Navy has provided the following items to SCVWD:

- (1) FFA between the Navy, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA), and the California EPA Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB), including schedule of deliverables,
- (2) Points of contact (POC) for the Navy, USEPA, RWQCB, and National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA),
- (3) Pertinent sections of the Station-Wide remedial investigation and Site-Wide Environmental Assessment,
- (4) Northern Channel Physical Characterization Report, and
- (5) Copies of the regulatory and Navy letters regarding the informal dispute at the Northern Channel.

Please note that MFA has a Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) that meets every three months. Seena Hoose and Tom Mohr of the SCVWD are MFA RAB members. You may wish to speak to these individuals to gain additional insight into MFA activities. The next RAB meeting is on May 10, 2001. We will include you on the invitation to these meetings; your attendance is welcome.
