RE: Comments on Community Relations Plan (CRP) for the
Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Studies at Naval Air
Station, Moffett Field, California

o Overall, the CRP appears comprehensive and on-target, however, we would recommend the following:

o The CRP should include a blow-up map of Moffett Field illustrating all areas of contamination (p.2-1a), in addition to the separate maps following Table 1.

o In the section entitled "Brief Description of Each Site", the authors should note the specific levels of contamination (p. 2-6) at each site.

o The cumulative plume from all sites is not discussed, nor is co-mingling of the Moffett contamination with the MEW plume mentioned (p.3-3). Addition of this information is desirable.

o Characterization of the public perception of contamination at the Moffett field as "insignificant" seems premature and unsubstantiated. An assessment and full characterization of the extent of contamination at the site has yet to be completed (p. 3-2).
