The Department of Health Services (DHS) has reviewed the Navy's preliminary ARARs for groundwater at NAS Moffett Field. During recent meetings, the Navy has indicated that due to the potential cut-back in water allocation to the base as a result of the drought, the base may need to utilize on-site wells. Based on this scenario, DHS believes that the document should be revised to reflect this possibility and the appropriate preliminary ARARs should be identified. In addition, DHS concurs with the Environmental Protection Agency's comments dated April 2, 1990, especially with regards to reviewing the Regional Water Quality Control Board's San Francisco Basin Plan for preliminary ARAR identification.
