### THE QUEEN ★★★★★

(CineArts, Century 20) Helen Mirren is perfection as Queen Elizabeth, not the be-wigged and Tudored version but the contemporary royal for whom a stiff upper lip is the order of the day. That credo is put to the test when Princess Diana is killed in a dramatic car crash inside a dark tunnel in Paris while being pursued by paparazzi. Newly elected British Prime Minister Tony Blair (Michael Sheen) is between a rock and a hard spot, anxious to spit-polish his image with a face of public concern yet clashing mightily with the tightly contained, ritual-bound world of his Queen. Blair and Her Royal Highness do emotional battle with all the diplomatic and procedural forces they can bring to bear while a staid Prince Philip (James Cromwell) staves pered doctor's wife. Unfortunately director Ryan Murphy and company lose touch of the emotional and physical squalor of the novel, creating an arch sense of comedy that is neither disquieting nor very intriguing. *Rated: R* for language, substance abuse and mature themes. 2 hours. — J.A.
