**NAVAL AIR STATION MOFFETT FIELD SITE 14 FIELD WORK PLAN**

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (Department) has reviewed the Site 14 Field Work Plan and has the following comments:

1. Page 9, last paragraph, the "long term O&M" is perplexing. Since, the duration of system operations will be one (1) year, it is not apparent what would "long term O&M" be referring to.
2. Page 11, paragraph 4, it is important to note that the duration of pump being off will not be known. Consequently, the operator will have no way of determining how long the unit has been in operation. Moreover, a back up plan should be in place if the well fails to produce the predicted 2 gpm.
3. Page 23, paragraph 3,
  - i. Please provide the frequency of measuring the flow rate.
  - ii. If the possibility of any water spill exists during flow rate measurement activities, a containment measure must be in place to capture the water.

Pursuant to Section 16 of FFA, the Department requests the Navy provide notification for any field activity prior to its commencement.


