The Navy provides many opportunities for the community to get involved in the environmental cleanup program at the former Naval Air Station Moffett Field. Below are several announcements and upcoming activities open to the public.

Site 25 Open House

You are invited to attend a public open house that will present the proposed cleanup plans for the former Moffett Field's Site 25, which includes NASA's Stormwater Retention Pond and Eastern Diked Marsh and the Midpeninsula Regional Open Space District's Stevens Creek Shoreline Nature Study Area.

The Navy is developing cleanup levels and evaluating alternatives for Site 25 that would allow property owners to implement tidal marsh and managed pond restoration in the future. These alternatives will be evaluated, along with others previously developed for the seasonal wetland land use.

During the open house, Navy, NASA and regulatory representatives will answer questions about the environmental cleanup at the site. We encourage you to attend and hope to see you there!

The RAB reviews and comments on plans and activities about the ongoing environmental studies and restoration activities under way at Moffett Field. Regular RAB meetings are open to the public and the Navy encourages your involvement.

You Can Be Involved in the Restoration Advisory Board

The Navy extends an invitation to community members to apply for membership to the Restoration Advisory Board for former NAS Moffett Field. The board, also called the "RAB," is an advisory body that acts as a focal point for the exchange of information about the Navy's environmental program. The RAB is comprised of concerned citizens, residents, business leaders, environmental activists, local city and county officials, NASA and regulatory agencies. Members advise the Navy on community concerns as they relate to environmental cleanup efforts and decisions; they promote community awareness of cleanup issues and encourage community involvement throughout the environmental restoration process. The Navy is always looking for special, dedicated people to enrich and diversify the RAB.


