Subject: Past use of Weapons Bunkers 70 through 74, 143, 147, and 528

Dear Lt. Col. Francisco:

This letter requests documentation of past users at the weapons bunkers listed above.

In September 1994, the U.S. Navy submitted for U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) review and comment, a draft Station-wide Remedial Investigation Field Work Plan to evaluate some additional sites at Moffett Federal Airfield (MFA). The evaluation of these sites had been requested by EPA and the State of California.

Comments on the draft work plan were received by the Navy in October and November 1994. In these comments, EPA requested that the Navy provide additional information on the past use of weapons bunkers 70 through 74, 143, 147, and 528. These weapons bunkers are shown on Figure 5 of the enclosed final Station-wide Remedial Investigation Field Work Plan.

During preparation of the Navy's response to comments on the draft work plan, you were contacted in December 1994 by PRC Environmental Management, Inc. (PRC), the Navy's contractor for this work. During conversations with PRC, it was understood that there is no evidence of any spill or release of hazardous materials, including nuclear material, at these bunkers. This information was included in the final Station-wide Remedial Investigation Field Work Plan (Section 3.1) and the response to comments (Comment 1).

For the record, EPA would now like this information in writing, as they have requested in their letter to me dated March 13, 1995 (enclosed). If, to the best of your knowledge, this information is still correct, please state so in a letter addressed to me.
