Dear Mr. Kadnuck:

Thank you for your followup letter, dated May 3, 1995, providing the additional information RWQCB staff requested concerning the Navy's proposed Self-Monitoring Program schedule. We find the proposal adequate and understand that the May 1995 sampling of Buildings 6 and 12 begin this new schedule. The start-up schedule for Building 45 has not yet begun due to the presence of metals above effluent limits. According to our telephone calls of the past two weeks and the data we have received from you by facsimile, you are currently trying to isolate the cause of the high metals concentrations within the system. Please continue to keep us informed of the status.

As mentioned previously, the required reports on start-up operations for Building 45 will need to be submitted weekly until it is fully operational. Reports for Buildings 6 and 12 can be submitted quarterly, beginning with July 15th, 1995. For chemical analyses, please provide the results (including laboratory detection limits) for all constituents at both influent and effluent sampling stations for all three treatment systems and Nasa Settling Basin.
