The Navy understands that the City of Palo Alto is currently identifying disposal options for dredge material as a result of the city's previous marsh land improvements and restoration operations. The Navy is interested in obtaining the 64,000 cubic yards of soils available from the above-referenced project.

The Navy, with the assistance of our consultants, has reviewed the analytical and physical data provided by the city from the dredge material and believes that the soils are suitable for use in construction of landfill covers at Moffett Federal Airfield. Our understanding is that the City of Palo Alto would provide handling and transporting of the dredge material to an off-site location. The Navy, therefore, would like to accept the dredge material and will provide stockpile locations at Moffett Field. The Navy would like to discuss schedules, logistical issues such as precise stockpile locations at Moffett Field, and coordination with NASA at your convenience.
